Scientific methods of beekeeping

A training programme on “Scientific Methods of Beekeeping” was organised for 25 farmer members of Banaskantha Dairy, Palanpur at NDDB Anand recently.

This training programme was sponsored by the National Bee Board (NBB) and facilitated by Sahara Gramodhyog Sansthan (SGS), Baghpat, Uttar Pradesh. During the week long training, farmers were provided hands on practical training on various aspects of scientific beekeeping and extraction of honey, royal jelly, pollen, propolis and bee venom.

The Government of India intends to promote beekeeping in the country as part of the doubling



of farmers income initiative. Under DAHD&F’s guidance the National Bee Board (NBB) is exploring the possibilities of promoting scientific beekeeping among interested dairy farmers through NDDB and the dairy cooperatives.
