

# 2 IIM profs in global consortium

**Ahmedabad:** Two faculties of Indian Institute of Management, Ahmedabad (IIM-A) — Chandan Kumar Jha and Ranjan Kumar Ghosh — are among the four researchers who are representing India at global Food, Agriculture, Biodiversity, Land and Energy (FABLE) consortium. The two other researchers include Vaibhav Chaturvedi from council on energy, environment and water and Manish Anand from The Energy and Resources Institute (TERI).
