

25 PG students of AAU to get international training

Vadodara/Anand: Twenty-five postgraduate (PG) students of Anand Agricultural University (AAU) will get international training at reputed foreign institutes and universities.

This will happen through the ICAR-World Bank sponsored National Agricultural Higher Education Project (NAHEP)-Center of Advanced Agricultural Science and Technology (CAAST) on secondary agriculture project, which will be administered by the Centre for Agricultural Market Intelligence.

A total of 40 PG students from different colleges of AAU were scrutinized and selected based on academic score, written test, interview, reservation policy and NAHEP guidelines by a selection committee under chairmanship of vice-chancellor Dr KB Kathiria.

Of the selected 25 students, 15 students are from the BA College of Agriculture, four students each are from the College of Food Processing and Technology, and the College of Agriculture Engineering and Technology at Godhra, and two students are from the College of Horticulture.

The students will undergo training from November 2022 to March 15, 2023.
