

Govt launches survey to assess crop damage in Jamnagar

A WEEK after heavy rainfall caused flash floods in Jamnagar district, the state government on Monday said that it has launched a survey to assess the damage caused to standing crops.

"Minister of State (independent charge) for Panchayat, Brijesh Merja, has issued instructions to launch a survey to assess the damage caused to standing crops by excessive rainfall in Jamnagar district," an official release said.

The release added that for speedier survey, 120 gramsevkas from Rajkot, Botad, Surendranagar and Devbhumi Dwarka districts have also been pressed into service.
