While the milk price was hiked by Rs 2 in Feb 2020, the price of curd had gone up in July by Rs 2 owing to the 5% GST levy. Nandini ghee prices have also gone up from Rs 518 a litre in Sept to Rs 620 by Nov. In Oct, Mother Dairy also increased the price of milk by Rs 2.
